Addendum / Corrigendum - 2/1

Sub: Partial Modification of Postgraduate (PG) Admission Guidelines (Session 2026–2027)

- (i) Inclusion of PG Course in affiliated UG Colleges under C.U. Centralized PG Admission Portal 2026 similar to 2025-26**
- (ii) Eligibility Percentage in Hons./Single Major subject would be 50% instead of 55%. Accordingly, 45% for SC/ST/PWD applicants instead of 50%.**

In partial modification of the previous notice regarding admissions to Calcutta University (C.U.) In-House PG courses and PG courses in affiliated Undergraduate (UG) Colleges, the competent authority has approved the following amendments for the academic session 2026–2027:

1. Re-inclusion in Centralized Portal: PG courses in affiliated UG colleges are now included in the Centralized Admission Portal for the 2026–2027 session, superseding the exclusion stated in the previous notice.
2. Relaxation of Eligibility Criteria: The minimum eligibility cut-off marks in the Honors/Single Major subject at the graduation level have been revised as follows:
 - 50% (instead of the 55% notified earlier) and
 - 45% for SC/ST/PWD (instead of the 50% notified earlier).
3. Unified Processing: The Centralized PG Admission Portal 2026 will handle all processes—including applications, entrance examinations, and merit list preparation—for both C.U. In-House courses and PG courses in affiliated UG colleges.
4. Admissions from Central Merit List: Affiliated colleges shall conduct their admission process strictly on the basis of the centralized merit lists generated for both PART-A and PART-B.
5. Seat Matrix Annexure: The complete list of PG courses available in affiliated UG colleges, along with the seat break-up for 2-Year and 1-Year PG programs, is attached herewith as an Annexure.
6. Merit List Categorisation:
 - PART-A: Exclusively reserved for current-year (2026) 6th-semester CCF applicants (the 1st batch under NEP 2020).
 - PART-B: Open to all eligible applicants (including the current batch and previous years' graduates).
7. Mandatory Entrance Test: Appearing in the Entrance Test is strictly mandatory for all categories of applicants.
8. No Separate College Applications: Affiliated UG College Authorities are instructed not to invite or accept fresh or separate applications at the institutional level for PG admissions.
9. Already applied applicants will get facilities to modify their preferences (inclusion of college preferences) if required.
10. **Last date of submission of online application and application fee extended upto 01-06-2026.**
