



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## *Message from the Principal, Vidyasagar College*



I have the honour to present "SPECTRUM", the Annual Report of Vidyasagar College for the academic year 2024–25, for the second time since my joining on 20th July 2024. The heritage Institution founded by Pundit Iswar Chandra Vidyasagar in the year 1872 remains committed to strengthening its academic environment and physical infrastructure to ensure holistic education.

During the year 2024–25, the College made notable progress in infrastructural development and digital transformation. Major works—including the renovation of the old building, modernization of the library, upgradation of the seminar room, and creation of a smart conference room—were completed. Projects such as elevator installation and the establishment of an institutional archive are underway.

Significant ICT initiatives were implemented, including a new college website, ERP-integrated student portal, smart class room, digital pollution monitoring display board, contributing to a sustainable institutional ecosystem.

Academically, the College performed well, with nearly 30% of final-year students securing a CGPA of 7 or above. Faculty members published 62 research papers and 30 books/book chapters. 35 seminars, including 3 international seminars, were organized by the departments. Six teachers served as research supervisors, five earned their PhDs, and three new faculty members joined the institution.

In sports, the College hosted the district sports inter college sport meet under the aegis of the Department of Higher Education, Govt. of West Bengal and achieved distinction by winning the Champions' Cup at both the district-level tournament and the prestigious inter-college football competition organized by S.A. Jaypuria College.

Students also engaged actively in social outreach, including a blood donation camp, tree plantation, and awareness programmes. NSS organized self-defence and cancer-awareness sessions; the Women's Cell conducted a gender-awareness programme; and the Internal Complaints Committee of the college arranged a legal awareness session in collaboration with the district legal aid cell.

I express my sincere gratitude to the President and members of the newly formed Governing Body for their guidance, and to the faculty, staff, and students for their dedication. Together, we shall continue to uphold the values of Vidyasagar College.

- 1896: Science curricula was introduced in F.A class.
- 1917: Metropolitan Institution was renamed as Vidyasagar College.
- 1942: Branch of Vidyasagar College was set up at Nabadwip.
- 1948: Branch of Vidyasagar College was set up at Suri.
- 1960: Women's section of Vidyasagar College was set up.
- 1961: Evening section of Vidyasagar College was set up for the Law courses.
- 1980: Vidyasagar College turned out to be a co-educational Institution.
- 2005: Completed 100 years of science teaching.

## VISION AND MISSION OF THE COLLEGE

The genesis of Vidyasagar College is a momentous and happy event in the National history of India, as its parturition midwife by none other than Pundit Ishwar Chandra Vidyasagar - the torch bearer of Indian Renaissance, took place in 1872 in the form of the Metropolitan Institution.

In this backdrop he set out to form a college that was run by the natives, with no help from the ruling British in shape or form. In fact, this college is the first one in India under the British yoke to be run entirely indigenously- the first attempt to free ourselves, in thought and practice, the first cry of freedom.

In accordance with the ideals set by Pundit Ishwar Chandra Vidyasagar and following the motto of knowledge, sacrifice and service the college aims to provide the best education possible to students coming from diverse backgrounds. As the founder sought to promote higher education as a part of his philanthropic social reform program, the college continues to make available special welfare and aid to backward and deprived sections of the society as well. It seeks to provide an environment of learning which is beyond the boundaries of caste, religion and gender. The students are exposed to structured learning through the college curriculum. They are offered guidance and suggestions to help them solve problems and are encouraged to acquire high academic standards. They are made aware of their moral responsibilities in a fast-changing multicultural world, and strengthened to surmount the evils of irrationality and intolerance.

### MISSION:

The foremost mission of Pundit Vidyasagar was to establish a completely national educational institution in the growing metropolis of the then Calcutta. It was Vidyasagar who was able to unite the western inquisitiveness and religious search for perfection in the realm of knowledge, with the tenderness and sympathetic warmth of the Indian heart.

Situated in a place, well connected transport-wise, the college as a flourishing center of learning draws in students from the suburbs and far-flung districts of West Bengal. Keeping in mind the rich and varied past the college hopes to inculcate among students year after year values of generosity and warm fellow feeling and finally to create a programme of actual human resource development, deploying social justice and ensuring equity, to foster competences amongst students. It has a mission to support, all its teaching-learning programs by values of traditional, eternal and ethical thoughts. It caters



its human and other resources to the backward and the underprivileged communities as well as advantaged regions of the society.

The mission is also communicated to the students through prospectus and the first day-lecture delivered by the Principal, Head of the Departments and other teachers during the “routine dictation procedure”.

Teachers, staff and other stakeholders are made aware regarding the mission through cultural programmes, college publications, prospectus, journals (Occasional volumes).

It was the crystallization of the vision of a visionary who believed that the education in our dependent country ought to be directed for the benevolence of the common underprivileged people.

The college endeavors to produce skilled professionals who can engage in the task of improving the world around them socially and economically.

The mission of the institution today is to enhance higher education, creating a dynamic environment through implementation of Higher Technology delivered educational opportunity in collaboration with private, public and semi-public organizations and to create a well-balanced program of actual human resource development, deploying social justice and ensuring equal opportunities among students.

#### **BACKGROUND IN THE FOUNDATION OF VIDYASAGAR COLLEGE**

The founding of the Metropolitan College in 1872, later named as Vidyasagar College in 1971, was not an isolated phenomenon, but a part of the great drama of Indian nationalism. The great founder of this college, Pundit Iswarchandra Vidyasagar, was a true representative of this nationalist spirit. Vidyasagar College was established at a time when the British colonial rulers were keen to establish their cultural dominance over the sub-continent to complement the political, social and economic hegemony on this rich land of ours.


Education has always been a handmaiden of change. Higher education in India was in the British age entirely controlled by the British Government and the Christian Missionaries. Again, education was very costly and was beyond the reach of most Indian families.



Iswarchandra took up the challenge, to resolve such issues, and in spite of vehement opposition from the British Government, ultimately succeeded in establishing the first private college in India completely under Indian management and taught by the Indians. This actually opened the door for young Indians aspiring towards higher education.

An educational institution of pre-eminence, Vidyasagar College is living evidence to the fact of history: it has truly stood the test of time, spreading the light of education among the people as thousands of students are shaped every year and are encouraged to go forward and face the realities of life in a manner befitting a good citizen. This has been going on for all a century and a half.

Vidyasagar College gave birth to a galaxy of notable persons who played vital roles in different spheres of national life leading to regeneration of India. Many of the teachers of the college were also eminent personalities whose achievements added glory to the rich heritage of the College. Vidyasagar College was developed as an institution where liberal arts was taught along the lines that the Pandit prescribed for the all-round development and well-being of the young individuals, who entered the portals of learning here.

The initiative aimed to replace the legacy system with a more robust, user-centric platform that could support real-time data management, student services, faculty coordination, and institutional reporting. With enhanced navigation, secure access controls, and modular ERP compatibility, the new website empowers stakeholders to interact seamlessly across departments—marking a significant step toward modernization and transparency in college operations.





Vidyasagar College has recently introduced a cloud-based ERP (Enterprise Resource Planning) system to modernize and streamline its academic and administrative operations. The new ERP integrates key functions such as admissions, fee payment, student information management, examinations, payroll, and internal communication into a unified digital platform, reducing manual work and improving transparency. By centralizing data and automating routine processes, the system aims to provide students with easier access to services and information while enabling faculty and administrative staff to work more efficiently. This

initiative marks a significant step toward the college's digital transformation, enhancing overall institutional effectiveness and supporting a more organized and responsive campus environment.

## Civil development works across Vidyasagar College's campuses



Civil development works across Vidyasagar College's three campuses are moving ahead steadily, with the Bidhan Sarani Campus receiving priority attention. Repairs on the ground and first floors—covering walls, floors, marble, tiles, classrooms, and corridors—are nearly complete, marking strong progress. The project has also opened the way for a full reconstruction of the toilet block and connecting areas, with plans to enhance safety and modernize facilities, including the exciting proposal for a capsule lift. The first phase has already been funded, and a refund is expected after completion, while the second phase is being carefully planned to ensure the building's long-term strength and functionality. Overall, the works reflect a forward-looking approach that combines restoration with thoughtful upgrades for the college's future.



Library's electrical system has been repaired and upgraded by WEBEL IDM using RUSA grant. WEBEL IDM carried out the first phase of electrical renovation on the ground and first floors of the Bidhan Sarani Campus, including replacing the main distribution unit, new wiring, and LED lighting. On 21st November 2025, Vidyasagar College marked a significant step toward sustainability and smart infrastructure by inaugurating a new digital pollution index board on campus. The innovative display will help students and staff stay informed about real-time environmental conditions. Alongside this, the college also unveiled a fully equipped smart meeting room designed to enhance collaboration through modern digital tools.

Together, these additions reflect the institution's commitment to technological advancement and a greener future.





Students get to know about real-life problem-solving applications, witnessed the architectural design of the supercomputer, and understood its immense computational power.

The team also visited the library of IIT Kharagpur, which was a remarkable experience for the students, as it is one of the largest and best libraries in India.



## STUDENTS PARTICIPATION IN NATIONAL SCIENCE DAY CELEBRATION

On February 28, 2025, the Department of Computer Science celebrated National Science Day, 2025, in the department's hardware and software laboratories. Many students from different schools participated in the program, which taught them the fundamentals of how embedded systems operate by illustrating a few real-world uses for sensors that are controlled by microcontrollers. The interaction sessions focused on the following illustrations done in the hardware laboratory by the 6<sup>th</sup> semester students of the department, mentored by Sri Arup Kumar Goswami and Smt. Soumita Chakraborty in the software laboratory:

1. The difference between analog and digital values
2. Ultrasonic sensor measures real-time distance of objects ahead of it
3. Arduino-controlled fire-alarm design
4. Servo motor spins to a particular predetermined angle.

Smt. Mausumi Paul arranged a quiz contest for the school students. All of the youngsters and accompanying school teachers. It was a fruitful and enlightening celebration of Science Day.



### Research Centre

The University of Calcutta had introduced a Research Centre of the P.G. ## THE RELEVANT CO-CURRICULAR EVENTS BY DEPARTMENT

### Exhibition on National Science Day, 28.02.2025

The Department of Psychology at Vidyasagar College, celebrated The National Science Day, on 28<sup>th</sup> February 2025 where students from nearby schools visited the college for a hands-on learning experience, aimed to familiarize young students with various psychological concepts through interactive lab sessions and experiments, that showcased real- world applications of psychological theories.

- **Reaction Time Experiment:** measuring their response times to stimuli, learning about the speed of cognitive processing and its connection to neural functioning.
- **Time Perception Experiment:** Students tested their ability to estimate time intervals, shedding light on the brain's perception of time.
- **Perceptual Reversibility Demonstration:** The visitors observed and interacted with visual illusions to understand how our brain can interpret the same stimulus in different ways.
- **Anxiety Test:** Students were introduced to basic methods of measuring anxiety levels by administering STAI (State Trait Anxiety Inventory) for gaining insights into how psychological assessments are used to evaluate emotional states.
- **Perceived Stress Scale:** Participants completed a simplified version of this scale to understand how perceived stress is measured and its impact on general mental health.
- **GHQ (General Health Questionnaire):** The students also filled out a simplified GHQ (version-28) to assess general health and emotional well-being, learning how psychologists use this tool to evaluate mental health status.
- **Cube Construction Test:** Students were introduced with the concept of intelligence and the simple method of measuring concrete intelligence by using this instrument.
- **Pneumograph:** Students were given proper instrumental demonstration and they were introduced about the process of measuring the level of arousal by changing the mental set of the participant and observed the changes in breathing pattern.








## STUDENT'S ACTIVITY
